

POST OPERATIVE WOUND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

If No Glue or Steri-Strips were applied

- 1. Keep the pressure dressing dry for 24 hours. Okay to shower after 24 hours and remove the pressure bandage.
- 2. If you see a waterproof dressing under the pressure bandage, keep in place for another 24 hours and remove after the next shower. Otherwise, proceed to 3.
- 3. Gently wash the area with soap & water or sterile saline to remove any crusting along the suture line.
 - a. Pat dry with a clean towel and apply Aquaphor or Antibiotic ointment.
 - b. Cover with a clean, non-stick bandage.
 - c. Repeat daily until your suture removal appointment.

If Glue or Steri-Strips were applied

- 1. Keep the pressure dressing dry for 24 hours. Okay to shower after 24 hours and remove the pressure bandage.
- 2. If you see a waterproof dressing under the pressure bandage, keep in place for another 24 hours and remove after the next shower. Otherwise, proceed to 3.
- Glue or Steri-strips will be in place. Do not remove. Avoid direct spray of the shower stream on the wound.
 a. After showering, dry them well with a clean towel or hair dryer.
- 4. No further wound care is necessary. If the strips or glue fall off, follow the "If No Steri-Strips or Glue was Applied" instructions.

If instructed to apply a Waterproof Wound Dressing Daily

- 1. Keep the pressure dressing dry for 24 hours. Okay to shower after 24 hours and remove the pressure bandage.
- 2. Keep the waterproof bandage on for another 24 hours (48 hours total).
- 3. After showering, remove the waterproof dressing.
 - a. Replace the waterproof dressing with a new non-stick pad and waterproof bandage. You do not need to clean the wound.
- 4. Change the dressing after each shower.
 - a. You may purchase the Waterproof Wound Care pack from our office for \$25.

If instructed to wear Compression Hose: Put on top of bandage in the morning and remove at bedtime.

There are several concerns following surgery:

Bleeding: Bleeding can occur following surgery. To reduce this possibility, follow these instructions.

- 1. No exercise for 48 hours.
- 2. Take only Tylenol or Extra- Strength Tylenol, avoiding aspirin or ibuprofen-based products for 48 hours.
- 3. Avoid alcoholic beverages for 24 hours.
- 4. Should bleeding occur: apply firm, constant pressure on the area for 20 minutes. If bleeding persists, call our office immediately.

Infection: The signs of infection are: increased pain, swelling, redness or a yellowish discharge from the surgery site. **Wound Opening**: To reduce this possibility, please follow these instructions.

- 1. If steri-strips were applied, dry them well after shower.
- 2. Avoid any exercise, activity, or movement that causes pulling or stretching of the site for 2-3 weeks after the surgery. (e.g. golfing, tennis, weight-lifting, running, yoga, etc.).
- 3. Avoid water sports of any kind. Showering is okay.
- 4. Avoid lifting over 10 pounds.
